

## Orientation and Mobility Training CPD session

The aim of this CPD training event is to provide participants with an update in professional Orientation and Mobility (O&M) practice. The event will review the foundations of O&M theory to examine if they are still fit-for-purpose and it will explore modern principles and thinking.

The session will look at identifying modern teaching techniques and compare the current equipment options available to meet the varying O&M needs of people with a visual impairment

Learning Outcomes – at the end of the session learners will be able to:

- Describe and explain how to implement up-to-date theory into modern practice
- Identify and explain how to implement a range of current teaching and learning methodologies in O&M practice
- State and compare the range of modern equipment available in the O&M 'toolbox'
- Demonstrate how to use a range of different teaching styles and selection of appropriate O&M equipment in practice
- State and identify how to evaluate O&M outcomes, and reflect on professional input and practice

Participants will be expected to bring their own observations and experience to the event.
